The disorder and confusion in the Punjab after the invasions of Nadir Shah and Ahmad Shah Abdali helped the rise of the Sikh power to a great extent. In A.D. 1764, the Sikhs assembled at Amritsar and struck the first coins of pure silver with legends of Degh, Tegh and Fateh. This was the first proclamation of the Sikh sovereignty in the Punjab.

The Sikh Empire (also Sikh Khalsa Raj or Sarkar-i Khalsa) was a major power originating in the Indian subcontinent, formed under the leadership of Maharaja Ranjit Singh, who established a secular empire based in the Punjab. The empire existed from 1799, when Ranjit Singh captured Lahore, to 1849 and was forged on the foundations of the Khalsa from a collection of autonomous Sikh misls.
