At this juncture Walthall's brigade was formed across the ridge at this point at right angles to its former line under a brisk fire, and held its position. The fire was kept up until after dark. Soon after 8 o'clock the brigade withdrew under orders, marching by way of the railroad bridge toward Chickamauga Station.

The regular battery was almost immediately recaptured by the 9th Ohio of Van Deriver's Brigade. At the same time Croxton's Brigade appeared on the left flank of Liddell's Brigade and both Walthall and Liddell were hastily withdrawn by their right flank and reformed in rear of Cheatham's line which was then arriving.
